Reporting of Child Protection Concerns – Coaches & Volunteers

There are a number of ways that OWHC communicate safeguarding procedures to its coaches, captains and volunteers.

All coaches, captains and volunteers are provided with a number of documents that outline safeguarding policy and reporting procedures:

- Code of conduct for coaches and assistants (attached)
- Code of conduct for club officials and volunteers (attached)
- Safeguarding of children policy (attached)
- Annual fixture card (relevant page attached)

All coaches, captains and volunteers are also provided with a 'Volunteer agreement form' together with the following documents:

- Code of conduct for club officials and volunteers
- Safeguarding of children policy
- Club equity policy
- Club emergency procedures

The agreement form is signed by the coach, captain or volunteer who agree to abide by club policy and procedures that includes the safeguarding of children, reporting processes, and details of the club welfare officer (See criteria 20c where all of the signed forms can be found)

All members including coaches, captains and volunteers are also provided with a fixture card each season that provides details of the safeguarding policy and details of the child welfare officer for reporting purposes.
