Code of Conduct for Club Members and Guests

Market Deeping Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members.

We believe that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents / carers or guardians associated with the Club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Members are therefore encouraged to be open and honest at all times and are invited to share any complaints or concerns they may have with any of the Officers listed in the header to this Code of Conduct.

As a member or guest of Market Deeping Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct.

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of Cricket
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed
- Display high standards of behaviour
- Promote the positive aspects of Cricket, e.g. fair play
- Encourage all participants to learn the Laws and rules and to play within them, respecting the decisions of match officials
- Actively discourage unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials
- Recognise good performance not just match results
- Place the safety and wellbeing of Young People above the development of performance
- Ensure that activities are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of the individual
- Respect Young People's opinions when making decisions about their participation in Cricket
- Not smoke, drink or use banned substances whilst actively working with Young People in the Club
- Not provide Young People with alcohol when they are under the care of the Club
- Members must pay any subscriptions and fees promptly
