### **GPDR Member opt in/out e-mail**

The Cornwall Hockey Umpiring Association (CHUA), a subset of the Cornwall Hockey Association (CHA) takes the privacy of our members' data seriously and will only use your personal information for club administration purposes, umpiring appointments, umpiring development and CHUA Meetings.

Your details **will be used to allow fixture secretaries to contact** you in order for them to source umpires for matches, these club secretaries will only have access to your data once that they have agreed that this is the only reason to contact you and that your data cannot be shared with any other third party.

Initially only the chairman, secretary, discipline officer and fixture secretaries will be able to access your details, however once the CHA website is up and running then you will have control over your data.

The CHUA will use your data to communicate with you about your membership.

The CHUA will never share your data without your prior permission.

Your explicit consent is required to share your personal data with CHA club secretaries and fixture secretaries' members which will comprise your qualifications as an umpire, your e-mail and telephone numbers. i.e. a contact list.

The CHUA will be inviting you in due course, once the website is fully functioning, to create a 'Member Profile' on the website from which your contact details will be 'invisible' to the sender. This system will allow you to set and amend your own privacy settings.

**However until this system is fully functioning then the intention is to continue to use contact lists.**

In accordance with the recent GPDR (Global Data Protection Regulations), **no return from you giving your explicit permission** will make it very difficult for the CHUA and indeed clubs to contact you.

Thus I request you to return to me by e-mail your consent for me to continue to use your data in the form of the following statement:

I, .....*insert name*..... give my consent for the CHUA to use my data in accordance with this statement for data use.

The CHUA secretary will then print and hold this consent and it will be updated annually or until you opt out.
