Record of Legitimate Interest Assessment for the Cornwall Hockey Umpires Association (CHUA)

Legitimate interest(s).

1. Data will be used for a contact list in order for the Secretary of the Cornwall Hockey Umpires Association (CHUA) to be able to:
 - a. Appoint umpires to matches in accordance with the Cornwall Hockey Association (CHA) Terms of Reference.
 - b. The data will also be shared with Fixture Secretaries of clubs affiliated to the CHA, this conduit is important so that other members can contact umpires in order to schedule matches.
 - c. Contact umpiring members on upcoming meetings, umpiring development opportunities and dates/venues of CHUA meetings
2. Without contact data the Fixture secretaries of clubs will have considerable difficulty in scheduling matches and indeed completing matches.
3. Use of the data is only to be used by the CHUA and Fixture secretaries of clubs for the following purposes:
 - a. Contacting umpiring members for pre-or post-match correspondence.
 - b. Contacting umpiring members for notice of CHUA Meetings and Umpiring development.
 - c. Contacting umpiring members for consent.
 - d. Contacting umpiring members for annual membership.

Necessity test.

The processing of data will be restricted to:

Name, Umpiring qualification, England Hockey Umpiring registration number, when they last umpired and contact details such as phone number and e-mail address.

These data attributes will be required to allow fixture secretaries or umpire co-ordinators to identify an umpire based on their EH qualification i.e. Level 1 Unassessed, Level 1 assessed, Level 2 or Level 3 Umpire.

Balancing test.

The sensitivity of the data is constrained to personal phone numbers and e-mail addresses. The data will be used to allow specific fixture secretaries and/or umpire co-ordinators of clubs who have been informed of how they are to use the data. Thus, individuals can be expected to be contacted on umpiring matters and duties and will have been made aware of this possibility.
