**Who will I be responsible to?**

The Cornwall County Hockey Association Committee

**What is my role?**

1. To action disciplinary matters including Red Cards, Match day Misconduct Offences (MMO) and Disrepute Charges occurring within Cornwall or involving players of Cornish Clubs.
2. Liaising with the West Regional Disciplinary Officer accordingly.

**What else can you tell me about the role?**

Operating procedures, pro-forma documents, regulations and systems of work are available for most eventualities. All will be available on-line through the England Hockey website.

Further advice can be provided through discussion with other County Disciplinary Officers and, should greater advice be required, then contact can also be made with the Regional Disciplinary Officer.

**How much time will I need to give to the role?**

Input is occasional and will depend on number of disciplinary matters highlighted during the course of the season. Approximately 2 hours per week will be required should an issue occur. (During 2016-17 season there were 3no Red Card issues to resolve).

**What tasks are involved?**

1. Red Cards – liaising with umpires, players and clubs when red cards have been shown, including completing associated documentation.
2. MMO's – liaising with umpires, players and clubs when red cards have been shown, including completing associated documentation.
3. Liaising with CDOs from neighbouring counties when cross-county issues arise.
4. Disrepute Charges – collating evidence and liaising with Regional Disciplinary officer.
