



Saffron Walden Cricket Club

Guidelines for use of net practice facilities at the Anglo American Playing Fields.

The club has two net cages each with two lanes for use by club members only. They may be used by non-members by arrangement with the Club coach or chairman. A charge of £25 per hour may be levied.

The old nets nearest the clubhouse are available for all members. They have a base of stone and sand. They are recommended for use by players under 13 years of age.

The new nets are available to all players qualified to play senior cricket (13+ or u12 county players). Younger players may use them but only under the supervision of experienced senior players or coaches qualified at Level 2 or above. The new nets have a tarmacadam base and play in a similar way to our main wicket in normal summer conditions.

Protective equipment (helmet, leg pads, abdominal protector, gloves) must always be used when practising with a hard ball

Footwear - spiked shoes should not be worn.

Bowling machine - this must only be used under the supervision of experienced senior players or Level 2 coaches or above. They are stored in the score box. A bowling machine stand is available.

Sidearms -these should ONLY be used by experienced senior players or Level 2 coaches or above and never with players under 16 years of age.

Security - the net cages can be dangerous places for both people and animals. They also represent a significant investment by the club. They must ALWAYS be left secure with the chain padlocked. This is the responsibility of the last person to leave the nets.
