

From early afternoon we will have a full BBQ (including vegetarian options) and a licensed bar serving beer, cider, wine, soft drinks and more.


This event is open to all so please feel free to invite your family and friends along. Fingers crossed for some sunshine... we hope to see you all there!



The Season So Far

On Saturday 11th May, the 1st XI secured a 31-run victory over New City, their first win of the season. Dave Quick was in excellent form with the bat, scoring an unbeaten 98 as the team reached 191-4. In reply New City were dismissed for 160 all out, with Matt Funge and Nirav Bhuva taking 3 wickets each.

Meanwhile, the 2nd XI suffered a narrow 12-run defeat away at Cublington. Despite needing just 117 to win, the team could only manage 104 all out. Kevin Woodward was the standout performer for The Guise, finishing the match with 3 wickets and 26 runs (not out) to his name.

The Sunday XI's second match of the season saw them welcome Lutonian to The Common. Having lost the toss and been put into bat, The Guise scored a below-par 100 all out. However, thanks to 4 wickets from Conor Lynch, Lutonian's reply of 67 all out meant The Guise walked away with a 33-run victory.

The following Saturday the 1st XI travelled to Newport Pagnell looking to avenge the defeat they suffered in the first match of the season. Rob Harrison picked up 4 wickets for 29 runs as Newport posted a total of 169 all out. Unfortunately The Guise could only manage 108 in reply, thereby falling to a 61-run defeat.

West Oxley Kings visited The Common to face the 2nd XI. Having been sent in to bat, West Oxley Kings were dismissed for score of just 47 runs - Bharath Sukumaran and Dave Evans collecting 3 wickets each. The Guise reached the target with the loss of just 1 wicket to secure a resounding 9-wicket victory.

The Sunday XI suffered a 38-run loss in their home match against Harrold, the team's second defeat of the season. Despite 3 wickets for William Trobe, Harrold reached a score of 167-7 from their 40 overs. The Guise fell short in their reply, managing a score of 129 all out – Calam Lynch contributing 45 runs.

On Saturday 25th May, the 1st XI headed to Great Linford to face a strong Printers side. Printers scored 222-6 from their 40 overs, whilst The Guise struggled to 108 all out for the second week running, resulting in a hefty 114-run loss.

Back at The Common, the 2nd XI came out on top in a very tight match against Wolverton, taking the points with a 1-wicket victory after chasing down the target of 143 in the 32nd over.

At home for the third match in a row, the Sunday XI thrashed Flitwick by 223 runs. Having been put into bat, The Guise racked up an imposing total of 297 thanks to a marvellous 112 from Calam Lynch and 73 from Ben Savage. In reply Flitwick were skittled out for a score of just 74, with Nirav Bhuva and Calam Lynch taking 3 wickets each.

The next Saturday saw the 1st XI face Harlington at The Common. Having won the toss, Harlington managed a score of 188-9 from an innings which saw Nirav Bhuva and James Carr collect 3 wickets each. The Guise reached the target in the 33rd over, thanks to 75 runs from Ben Savage and 76 from Calam Lynch, to give the team an impressive 7-wicket victory.

Over at Great Linford the 2nd XI came up well short against Printers, going down to an 8-wicket defeat. Despite 60 runs from Alex Searle, The Guise could only manage a total of 136 which Printers chased down comfortably with the loss of just 2 wickets.

The Sunday XI suffered another loss at the hands of Harrold, this time by the margin of 33 runs. Conor Lynch and Calam Lynch took 3 wickets each as Harrold posted 146 all out. Unfortunately The Guise could only reply with 113 all out.

On Saturday 8th June, the 2nd XI fixture against Harlington fell victim to the weather with conditions at The Common deemed unfit for play. Meanwhile, in their match at Great Horwood, the 1st XI struggled with the bat, managing a very disappointing score of 52 all out. Great Horwood easily knocked off the runs with the loss of just 2 wickets to give them an 8-wicket win.

The following day the Sunday XI made the long(ish) journey to Biggleswade. Having been sent in to bat, The Guise scored 161 all out, with Srikanth Chundi contributing in 53 runs. In reply Biggleswade could only manage a score of 140 all out, as Tyrone Pickersgill bagged 3 wickets in the 21-run victory.
