

In association with Tennis Wales we have prepared a new set of guidelines.

All social and club sessions will continue to be suspended until further notice.

Outdoor courts will be open for singles, but only for doubles if all four players are members of the same household.

On outdoor courts, one-to-one tennis coaching, as well as a game of singles with someone from outside your household, will be permitted.

Players are being advised to initial their tennis balls, so they only pick up and serve with their own set, and the LTA also recommends players do not change ends - or, at the very least, do so at opposite sides of the net.

Bring your own equipment - the minimum necessary - and only touch your own tennis balls.

Initial those balls, so you know which ones to serve with, and return ones which aren't yours with either your racquet or foot.

Avoid changing ends every couple of games, and bring a full water bottle and some hand sanitiser to the court with you.

Do not try to adjust the net. Venues are being told to ensure they remain at the appropriate height.

You may have nowhere to sit because unnecessary equipment such as benches have been disabled.

We have a booking system using our members Bulletin Board on our website. Slots will only be bookable a maximum of 24 hrs in advance to ensure a fair opportunity for everyone. Members must reserve a specific court for say blocks of ½ an hour up to 2 hours, if members arrive without checking the booking system and not reserving a slot they must not play. Try to finish 5 minutes before the end of the session.

Allow others to leave the courts before you enter if you need to wait then do so away from the courts and away from the entrance Please leave space around the gates. Be careful touching the gate lock wipe your hands afterwards.

Double check to ensure you take all your belongings and litter with you at the end of your session, you must not leave anything on court.

Please do not congregate after playing...no extra-curricular activity or social activity should take place

Unless a key holder is present then our tennis room and toilets will be closed.

If your membership or fee has lapsed you will not be able to play!
