



Terms and Conditions of pitch hire during the corona outbreak

Guidelines

- England Hockey Return to Play guidelines must be adhered to at all times together with current Government guidance and EH Coaching Guidelines if U18's are present.
- Coaches must be familiar with Covid specific Risk Assessments and have up to date Safeguarding Certification, DBS checks etc.
- Players should always adhere to any localised lockdown restrictions.

Preparing to play

- Bookings must be made via Julie Carter – juliecarter47@outlook.com Bookings made by sections will be invoiced in the usual way and all participants must have paid beforehand as no cash is to be accepted at the pitch.
- Coaches must have records of who attends each session should we need to trace players following a report of any Covid symptoms.
- Individual or family sessions can be catered for but must be paid for in advance. Any groups comprising of U18's must have a responsible adult with them at all times and adequate First Aid arrangements.
- Hygiene – in line with Government advice wash hands before and after activity and regularly use hand sanitiser.
- Equipment – coaches are responsible for sticks, balls, cones and any other coaching equipment.
- Players must arrive ready to play, there will not be any access to changing rooms. The clubhouse is out of bounds, which includes the toilets.

Access

- Arrive in time for your booking and allow others to leave before you enter – if you need to wait stay away from the entrance or gates.
- Entry is to be gained using the fob only and the key pad must not be used.
- Do not congregate after playing. No extra curricular or social activity should take place.

Playing

- Advisable to take your own hand gel or gloves.
- Where possible attendees should avoid touching gates, fences, dividing curtain or goals.
- Dug outs should not be used.
- Follow instructions and distancing rules set out on the site.
- Any injuries will be the responsibility of the hirer to deal with.
- Maintain social distancing at all times outside your group booking.
- Remember to take all your belongings at the end of the booking as items will be disposed of.

If you are showing any signs of Covid-19 or have been in contact with anyone suffering symptoms you should not attend the booking.

We anticipate that processes will be continually reviewed, updated and monitored. Anyone found not to be complying with the above may have their booking suspended.

Please note: Guidelines may be updated as we enter different stages of the Government and EH Guidance by putting together tighter restrictions or easing of restrictions accordingly.
