Parent/Carer Guidance for Covid 19 Return to Play

September 2020

Corsham HC is delighted to have our Junior Section back on the pitch for training sessions but there are a few changes and we are all responsible for playing our part to keep everyone safe. Invitation to Training Sessions

Step 1

Your child will only be invited to training once their [England Hockey Participation Agreement](#) has been completed.

All player and Parent/Carer details need to be updated on ClubBuzz and registration completed for 2020/21 season.

Step 2

You will receive a ClubBuzz Selection email for training sessions, entitled: "Corsham Hockey Club - Match selection details"
Please respond to this email by clicking on either 'Accept' or 'Decline' **48 hours prior** to the training session.

Please note: ClubBuzz reporting systems will be used to compile Attendance Registers which have to be sent to England Hockey (EH) within 24 hours of each hockey session. The data will be held securely by EH for 21 days in line with GDPR. All data held by Corsham HC is kept within ClubBuzz in line with GDPR.

Before Leaving Home

In line with guidance from EH, Corsham HC asks all parents/carers and children to **self-assess for Covid-19 symptoms before each hockey session**. No-one should leave home if they, or someone they live with, has any of the following:

- a) A high temperature (above 37.8 degrees C)
- b) A new, continuous cough
- c) A loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste

If you or your child have any of the above symptoms **DO NOT** come to the pitch and follow NHS guidance on self-isolation.

Arrival at the Pitch – please refer to the Pitch Access Visual

Ideally only one parent/carers should accompany their child.

Do not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes before the start of a training session.

Please socially distance at 2m while queuing with your child to enter the pitch. **DO NOT** bunch at the gate entrance. Please queue along the path between the fence and the car park.

Entering the Pitch

Please accompany your child to the gate and ensure they are checked in by a member of the coaching team (**only those players who have Accepted the selection email from ClubBuzz 48 hours before the session will be permitted to train**).

Leave your child to enter the pitch as advised. They will be asked to sanitise their hands.

NO spectators are allowed within the main gate. However, we do require that a parent/carer remains within the vicinity of the Springfield Campus (for all U10s & U12s) eg you could sit in your car. **Parents/carers of U8s need to stay within visual contact of their child for safeguarding purposes.**

Please do not gather in groups of more than 6 people and keep to the 2m social distance guidelines wherever possible.

Toilet Access & First Aid

Please ensure your child has visited the toilet before leaving home. If a child needs the toilet during a session they will have to be accompanied by their parent/carer and taken to the toilet facilities inside the Springfield Centre (currently only 1 toilet is open).

If a child requires First Aid, their parent/carer will need to assist (hence why you need to stay). If the injury is serious we will use common sense and a trained First Aider will administer emergency First Aid using PPE until the parent/carer arrives.

Collecting Your Child

Please start queuing down the path between the gate and the car park at least **5 minutes** before the end of the session. Please maintain 2m social distance in the queue.

As you reach the front of the queue we will call your child to the gate and check them out. They should sanitise their hands on exit.

Please leave promptly and do not gather in groups of more than six in the car park.

At Home

If your child displays any symptoms of Covid-19 after playing hockey, contact the Corsham HC Covid Officer immediately and contact NHS Test & Trace.

NB: Corsham HC will **NOT** disclose your child's name but will advise other session attendees that someone has developed symptoms. This is to enable attendees to remain vigilant. Other attendees will only need to self-isolate if they have been contacted by NHS Test & Trace.
