Club Joining Fees & Subscriptions

Junior Membership (Age 15 and under)

£40 For the first term

£30 per term (£90 annually)

Your child will receive a FREE Club t-shirt that is to be worn to training sessions and whenever they are representing the Club.

Student Membership (Age 16+ in full time education)

£15 Joining Fee

£10 per month (£120 annually)

You will receive a FREE Club t-shirt that is to be worn to training sessions and whenever you are representing the Club.

Senior Membership (Age 18+)

£20 Joining Fee

£20 per month (£240 annually)

You will receive a FREE Club t-shirt that is to be worn to training sessions and whenever you are representing the Club.

Training Member – SENIORS ONLY (required after 2 sessions)

You should complete the application form as 'Training Only' and affiliate to England Netball (see next section).

Your first session is free after which it is £4 per session.

The monthly fee covers:

- Training fees which includes venue hire
- Equipment, balls, bibs etc
- League and Tournament Fees
- First Aid Equipment
- Club Website Fees & Club Development
- Coaches and Umpires

Non-payment of subscriptions will result in loss of eligibility to training or representation/selection for upcoming Club fixtures until you bring your outstanding fees up to date.

Training

Training is roughly scheduled every Wednesday except half terms, Christmas, Easter and summer holidays. Other exceptions will be listed on our website. We do like you to attend training as often as possible, but of course we understand that there are some weeks that you just can't make. Training is very important to develop and improve everyone's netball skills and for members to benefit from being part of a Club. We do try to have matches during the last part of training, which gives everyone good practice for the real thing.

Juniors training is 6.00-7.00pm at Bishopshalt School Outdoor Courts, Royal Lane, Uxbridge, Middlesex UB8 3RF.

Bishopshalt School: The outdoor courts are visible upon entry by the school gates. Please make sure cars are parked in the car park, to the left when you drive in, rather than right next to the courts.

Changing room and toilet access is available at both venues.

Seniors training is 7.30-9.00pm at Uxbridge College Indoor Sports Hall, Park Road, Uxbridge UB8 1NQ

Medical Matters

All Blaze NC Coaches have First Aid qualifications. Any member who has Asthma is expected to bring their inhalers to ALL matches and training. Junior member inhalers must be labelled with their names and GIVEN to the Coach or PLACED in the designated area for the duration of the session. The same applies to any member with conditions that may require Adrenalin Auto injectors or other quick response interventions.

Kit

At training you should wear your Club t-shirt, appropriate sports clothing and a specific sports bra should be worn during training and matches. We also recommend that you invest in a good pair of trainers, preferably netball or tennis specific ones. This is to increase the longevity of the sole as they are designed to withstand the 'wear and tear' caused by multidirectional movement on court surfaces.

Wearing kit helps you feel part of your team and part of the Club. As you are representing the club, for all matches you are required to wear our club dress which is available to purchase from <http://blazenetballclub.bigcartel.com/>. Items such as tracksuits, sweatshirts and socks are also available to purchase.

EN Disciplinary Regulations January 2019

Codes of Conduct for Parents & Carers

EN has Codes of Conduct across the sport which is driven by its' core values of leadership, integrity, teamwork and excellence. Our codes require the highest standards of conduct from everyone involved in netball to ensure that their behaviour and actions meet the values and standards expected of them at all times. The enjoyment and safety of your child when they are involved in a netball activity is of paramount importance to EN. Every child will be encouraged and asked to ensure that their behaviour and actions meet the values and standards expected of them at all times. As parents, you are also asked to support our Codes of Conduct and embrace the spirit of our game.



As a parent/carer, I will:

- 1 Encourage my child to play within the rules and respect officials' and coaches' decisions
- 2 Support my child's efforts and performance, give positive comments that motivate and encourage continued effort and learning
- 3 Understand that competition is about winning and losing, so results are always accepted without undue disappointment
- 4 Be a positive role model to my child by helping them work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship
- 5 Remember that children learn best by example; I will applaud good play by both my child's team and their opponents
- 6 Thank the coaches, officials and other volunteers who give their time for my child and not interfere with their decisions
- 7 Help when asked by a coach or official
- 8 Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of gender, marital status, race, colour, disability, sexuality, age, occupation, religion or political opinion
- 9 Read the rules of the sport to understand better what I am watching and discussing with my child
- 10 Promote this code of conduct to other parents, carers and supporters
- 11 Be aware of my child's club safeguarding policy and ensure that any concerns are reported to the club's safeguarding officer or England Netball's Lead Safeguarding Officer.

As a parent/carer, I will not:

- 12 Pressure my child in any way; I know that this is their sport not mine
- 13 Use inappropriate language, harass athletes, coaches, officials or other spectators
- 14 Criticise or ridicule my child for making a mistake or losing after the game
- 15 Force my child if they are unwilling to participate in the sport
- 16 Arrive at a netball activity under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- 17 Use Social Media technology to bring the game into disrepute or make an inappropriate comment about an athlete, coach, official, volunteer or member of England Netball staff
- 18 Consume illegal substances either immediately prior to or while being at a netball activity where my child is participating in the sport
- 19 Consume alcoholic drinks or smoke either immediately prior to or while being at a netball activity where my child is participating.

Codes of Conduct for Athletes

EN has Codes of Conduct across all aspects of the sport, which is driven by its' core values of leadership, integrity, teamwork and excellence. Our codes require the highest standards of conduct from everyone involved in Netball to ensure that their behaviour and actions meet the values and standards expected of them at all times.

Netball Sport ethic: **Respect, Teamwork, Achievement and Fun**

By abiding by these Codes of Conduct, netball players can achieve respect, good sportsmanship, high standards of behaviour and ethics to provide them with an enjoyable, safe and stimulating experience.

Everyone must conduct themselves in an honest, fair, impartial and transparent manner.

I **will Respect:**
(*Player's name*)

- ▶ The rules, regulations and requirements of the Sport, including, but not limited to, any competitions in which I participate either directly or indirectly
- ▶ The rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in netball, regardless of any protected characteristic (age, disability, gender reassignment, marriage and civil partnership, pregnancy and maternity, race, religion or belief, sex, and sexual orientation)
- ▶ The rights, dignity and worth of Children, Young People and Adults at Risk and ensure that I am aware of the Safeguarding best practice guidelines and procedures when interacting with them.
- ▶ Confidentiality and the sensitivities of information I hold on other individuals
- ▶ Netball and the individual's reputation and not take any action or make inappropriate comments about a fellow participant, coach, official, volunteer or member of England Netball's staff that will bring the Sport or those associated with delivering the Sport into disrepute, including making comments on social media technology. I will respect EN's guidance and policies on social media technology.
- ▶ The position I hold within Netball and always conduct and dress myself in an appropriate manner.
- ▶ The result of the game and will not attempt to offer, offer or accept either directly or indirectly any consideration whatsoever in return for influencing or attempting to influence the result or seek to achieve personal gain on a result which I can influence by betting on any match or event where I am participating, either by playing, coaching or officiating, or through direct or indirect involvement.

Netball is based on Teamwork, therefore I will:

- ▶ Not abuse or misuse any relationship of trust or position of power or influence held by me in my team, be that my playing team, Club, County, Regional or England Netball
- ▶ Be on time, dressed appropriately and ready to give my full attention to the role I am carrying out within Netball
- ▶ Recognise that individuals bring different qualities and attributes but "together we will excel".
- ▶ Welcome new members, volunteers, and connected participation and cooperate with Members, Connected Participants, colleagues, coaches, officials and administrators already in the Sport.

I recognise individuals participate in Netball to achieve and have fun, therefore I will:

- ▶ Recognise the achievements of others and applaud their successes
- ▶ Endeavour to ensure that all involved in the Sport optimise their potential by promoting the positive aspects of the sport and never condoning the use of inappropriate or abusive language, inappropriate relationships, bullying, harassment, discrimination or physical violence.
- ▶ Not impinge on others enjoyment of the Sport or my performance by consuming alcoholic drinks or smoke immediately prior to or while participating in the sport, or while safeguarding children, young people or vulnerable adults
- ▶ Ensure that everyone has the opportunity to participate in a fair, honest environment by rejecting cheating, abiding by the Anti-Doping policies and not taking illegal substances immediately prior to or while participating in the Sport.
- ▶ Display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat; be sporting – whether I win or lose; always acknowledge the other team and the umpires at the end of the game with a hand shake or three cheers.
- ▶ Never argue with an official or participant during a game and listen to and cooperate with officials' decisions
- ▶ Control my temper; I understand that verbal, emotional and physical abuse of officials, coaches, spectators or participants, or deliberately distracting or provoking a participant, coach or official is not acceptable or permitted behaviour in netball
- ▶ Enjoy the game and ensure other can also enjoy it.

I will endeavour to abide by these codes of conduct and promote them to others.

I understand that if I fail to follow the code, then England Netball, the Regional Association or the County Association may take action against me under the Disciplinary Regulations which may result in Sanctions including fines and suspension.

Social Media Acceptable Use Agreement

- ▶ I will not arrange to meet anyone without the knowledge and consent of my parent/carer;
- ▶ I will not deliberately browse, download, access or post any material that could be offensive, threatening or illegal;
- ▶ I agree to report material, posts or contacts which I find upsetting or cause me concern;
- ▶ I understand that if there is need for anyone to take action as a result of my use of social media in the sport of netball, my parent/carer may be contacted.
