

LTA/Tennis Wales 'Play Safe' Guidelines for return to RESTRICTED play

- 1. Singles and doubles from several different households are now permitted to play. Larger organised group activity of up to 30 adults will be allowed from Monday 26th April but all MUST maintain the 2 metre social distancing rule.**
- 2. Players should try not to change ends, but if they do so they MUST pass at opposite ends of the net plus social distancing.**
- 3. Each player should take their own clearly marked balls, and should still try to avoid direct contact with other's balls, however they can pick up other's players' balls on the same court, BUT if they do so, they must not touch their face until they have sanitised/washed their hands.**
- 4. Stray balls from other courts should not be picked up by hand.**
- 5. Must be about a 10 minute buffer time between bookings, players should vacate 10 minutes before the next session.**
- 6. Must remember not to wait/congregate around the court gate or on court...social distancing applies, note 2m yellow lines at gate.**
- 7. Club MUST keep records of all court users for 21 days for Track and Trace, therefore the person booking the court MUST list on the booking the names of ALL the people playing at that session...this is an official requirement!**
- 8. Each individual should ensure they act responsibly as breaching the rules/guidelines could result in closure of the courts and possibly disciplinary action.**
- 9. If you or a family member have any of the advised Covid-19 symptoms please do not come to play.**
