Players

Players should adhere to all hygiene and social distancing standards as laid down by the ECB (eg. Hygiene breaks every six overs, no use of changing rooms, return to vehicles in the event of wet weather, provide own drinks and teas. Home team to left of clubhouse verandah as one looks at it, away team to right

Spectators

Adhere to all current social distancing guidelines (eg. Groups of 6 or two households, 1m+ apart), use of vehicles in the event of wet weather, access to toilets only in Pavilion but must sign in or scan QR code, do not sit within 2m of boundary, do not touch ball, do not sit in front of Pavilion

People Management and Communication		
	Self-screening of individuals before they arrive at the venue to ensure individuals displaying COVID-19 symptoms or those who should be shielding do not travel or attend.	All members told not to attend if they have symptoms. (Captains) Guidance and any updates issued to all members via weekly newsletter and website
	An assessment of user numbers, space capacities, venue circulation and layout planning to maintain social distancing.	Pavilion not available except for use of toilets. Toilets open on a restricted basis. Use cubicles where possible, wash hands before and after use, respect 2m social distancing, all those entering Pavilion must sign their name, telephone number, time in and out to support Track and Trace if necessary. (SWCC captain)
	A plan for where parents and players will sit whilst watching cricket activities.	Visitors not in front of clubhouse and not within 20m of clubhouse. Home players to the left of the club house as you look at it and away to the right. (Captains). Club representatives will make visits to support Captains.
	Staff and volunteers to support the implementation of the plan.	SWCC supporters including parents to support captains.
	Players	To follow all ECB guidelines on field in terms of hygiene, ball cleaning, social distancing. Players to bring own food, drinks, chairs and sanitiser

Buildings		
	Assess ventilation in your building (natural and mechanical) and take appropriate measures to maximise ventilation and minimise risk of transmission.	n/a - no access to clubhouse other than toilet access. Changing rooms locked, Access only to disabled toilet.
	Assess the maximum occupancy of your rooms at 2m social distancing (or 1m with risk mitigation where 2m is not possible) and establish a suitable circulation system/one-way system. Use signage and floor markings to communicate this.	Scorers to sit outside and min 2m apart. No scorebox. Scorers to sit with their teams at either end of the verandah, respecting social distancing guidelines (2m or 1m + with mitigation)
	Assess the arrangement of seating areas to maintain social distancing and minimise the risk of transmission.	No teas or lunches served. Players to bring own food, drink and sanitiser. Access to toilets permissible, cubicle use encouraged. Spectators not to sit within 10 m either side of clubhouse, not less than 3m from boundary in groups of no more than six or no more than 2 households.
	Consider your wet weather plans and describe what actions you will take to maintain social distancing in wet weather.	Players and spectators to shelter in cars (or under Pavilion verandah but only if social distancing can be respected). Pavilion is for toilet use only and should not be used for shelter.
Social and Hospitality Areas		
	Plan to solicit and maintain records of your member attendance, customers and visitors - to be maintained for 21 days and then destroyed.	Signing in system for those using toilets - date, name, telephone number, time in and, ideally, time out.
	Visitor management	Visitors should not sit within 10m of The Pavilion. Groups of 6 only (or 2 households). Toilets available users must sign in (as above). Social distancing of 2m (1m+ with mitigation) to be respected at all times. Visitors should bring their own sanitiser and refreshments

Hygiene and Cleaning	
Provision of hand washing facilities with warm water, soap, disposable towels and bin.	For those using toilets only. All players to provide own sanitiser. Hand washing signage displayed.
Provision of suitable hand sanitiser in locations around the facility to maintain frequent hand sanitisation.	Fixed dispensers available.
Provision of suitable wipes and hand sanitiser on the field for hygiene breaks.	Players and coaches to provide their own. Club to use scoreboard, stumps, bails and boundary markers provided and sanitise at end of match. Club to provide own scorebook and bowlers markers.
Cleaning arrangements	The Pavilion will be cleaned before and after use with particular emphasis on touch points Whilst in use, touchpoints will be cleaned including bench.
Who might be harmed?	Facility users, staff, volunteers and visitors
Controls required	Action Taken by the Club
Check that your ground is ready and safe to play. Look at what work is required and how this can be done safely at a social distance.	Groundsman Running lines to be marked on each side of wicket at 2m distance
What are the hazards?	Pitches or outfield are unsafe to play on
Who might be harmed?	Players, officials, ground staff
Controls required	Action Taken by the Club

Preparing your Grounds	
Check and repair of any damage to pitches and outfields.	Groundsman with feedback from Captain via fixture co-ordinator
Surfaces checked and watering regime adjusted based on lack of rainfall.	Groundsman with feedback from Captain via fixture co-ordinator
