#### 1. Welcome from the Chairman RH.

Welcome to the 54th AGM for KHC to review the 2021/22 season, a complete post covid season, but with after shock effects from the pandemic plus England Hockey's (EH) new admin and new League structure to negotiate.

## 2. Apologies for Absence

## 3. Minutes of 2021 AGM

Minutes agreed and signed.

#### 4. Treasurer's Report by RB

#### RB reported on the completed accounts for the 2021/22 season.

- The 2021/22 Club account details were distributed to those in attendance (and are an appendix to these minutes).
- Loss for year £600, loss for previous 2020/21 season £3,000.
- Reserves at end of season are £15,164

- KHC savings brought about this season as reduced ground rent payments were made to KSC on account that grass pitches were no longer required / used.
- New EH membership package has brought about savings on insurance and provided personal injury cover to all.
- The loss of a sponsor for season was covered by one off receipt of £1,500 when the Club switched accounts from NatWest to Metro Bank.
- Membership fees rose £1,500 to £10,706 but still didn't cover pitch hire costs of £12,509.
- £851 raised from social events

## RB continued to advise with regard future funding and expenditure

- Future funding of the Club will have to take into account that over the last two covid seasons the Club has started to use up its reserves and (also as a consequence of covid) total membership has fallen.
- KHC need to be aware of general across the board increases in costs and this will need to be reflected in rent to KSC.
- Next season's rent to KSC will be £8,100 (from £7,500 this year).
- New admin system of EH -GMS will assist in the future in recovering missing membership subscriptions (but not this season, GMS not yet fully operational/functional).
- New online kit purchasing has removed losses to Club on unsold stock.
- More use of the Clubhouse for social events will be beneficial to KSC and KHC
- Warlingham pitch fees expected to remain unchanged.
- Some expenditure on kit (goal keeper) anticipated in forthcoming season.
- Guidance was that tea costs should be £20/£25

## **Annual Subscriptions and Match Fee Proposals**

- No proposal to change Colts' subs. Agreed unanimously, Colts subs £40
- No Proposal to change Seniors' subs. Agreed unanimously £144 adults with £85 for students/unwaged.
- Proposal to change match fee. Proposal agreed by the members Seniors £10 per match, unwaged and juniors £5 per match.

#### **Additional Actions**

RH thanked RB for all his hard work as Treasurer.

## 5. Sports Club Report by PB

- KSC (like KHC) had gained £1,500 for changing its Bank Accounts from NatWest to Metro Bank.
- Ben Fancourt had worked hard to secure rebates and grants from the Council to cover losses incurred as a result of covid.
- KSC surplus currently £20,000.
- Bridge Club are slowly increasing their rent back up to precovid level of £200 per month.
- Gas alone was up to £3,000 p/a so KHC looking at a £1,500 increase.
- Chiller in bar has recently broken, Robin arranging early replacement.
- External tap has been installed for cricket pitch and square maintenance.
- Additional cleaning over summer has been due to high usage and has been paid by the cricket club.
- Any music that is played at the Club requires a licence and this should be factored into event arrangements.
- Bar is now cash free.
- Discount button on bar till is not to be used.

- Plans to create an overarching website for the Sports Club and to include KHC & KCC.
- Planning to also develop Clubhouse and move it forward, new ideas and thoughts welcomed and the request for members to come forward with ideas for events was restated.
- The Clubhouse will be open and showing matches for the football world cup.

## 6. Club Captains' Reports

#### SN reported for the ladies

Three ladies teams competed in the EH restructured league.

Ladies 1st XI finished 3rd and have recently discovered they will be promoted to play in Division 1. Ladies 2s finished bottom and will play in Division 4 next season and the 3rd XI will continue to play in Division 5.

New players have come to the Club and enjoyed the club social side.

Looking forward to next season and with hope that some promising youngsters at training will come up and play on a regular basis for the ladies teams.

A coach has been secured for training next season and has also committed to attend one ladies match per month with view to seeing all three teams. (replacing Josh Lawrence who had been unable to commit to Thursdays as anticipated and Margo who had stepped in as emergency cover). SN thanked the Captains, Kate Davies (Welshie), Michelle Van Huyssteen and Emma Rodrigues and all those that had umpired the ladies matches.

## RH reported for the Men's and Vets sides

1st XI had found it a tough season and battled hard but will go down a division next season and this will allow them to reorganise.

2nd XI had a difficult start but got stuck in and finished mid table. If availability can improve next season this will give more stability to the side.

3rd XI finished 8th which was pleasing with a lot of colts coming through and in their first senior season.

The Vets team had their most successful season ever, helped by good team availability. Nick Gane moved to keep for the 1st XI and Gavin Harris replaced him in the vets team. All fixtures were friendlies and it was a very enjoyable season.

Generally the mens' section needs a recruitment drive and hopefully some former members may return too.

**RH** thanked Shelly and Chris for their work over the season and also thanked the team captains for their hard work too.
