Guidelines for dealing with an injured person

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation
- · Listen to what the injured person is saying
- If the injury is minor, alert the first aider to take appropriate action, all coaches are first aid trained. If no coach present, a guidance leaflet is in the first aid box in pavillion
- If the injury requires special treatment, call the emergency services
- Do not move someone with major injury; wait for the emergency services
- Contact the injured person's next of kin / parent
- Report the incident / accident on the clubs Accident Form.

Location of first aid equipment

First aid boxes are located in two places. One in the club house in a cupboard opposite the main entrance door. The other in the Pavillion in the kitchen cupboard.

A defibrillator is located on the outside of wall of the club house. Always call 999. After turning the defibrillator on, follow the verbal instructions from the machine.
