3a. **Senior** members joining the club after the start of season pay a £50 standing charge plus a pro-rata payment based on the number of months left in the playing season.

3b. **Junior** members joining the club after the start of season pay a £30 standing charge plus a pro-rata payment based on the number of months left in the playing season.

4a. DWHC will assess each **senior** members subscription status and payment records regularly throughout the season. Players not demonstrating regular payments (or complete payment) will be **excluded** from further selection (Outdoor / Indoor) and will pay the **complete** balance of their fees to date - plus 50% of their outstanding (Outdoor / Indoor) subscription before being considered eligible to play for the club in any league, cup or friendly match.

4b. DWHC will assess each **junior** members subscription status and payment records regularly throughout the season. Players not demonstrating regular payments (or complete payment) will be **excluded** from further selection (Outdoor / Indoor) and will pay the **complete** balance of their annual subscription before once again becoming eligible for selection in any league, cup or friendly match.

3b. Junior members joining the club after the start of season pay a £30 standing charge plus a pro-rata payment based on the number of months left in the playing season.

4a. DWHC will assess each senior members subscription status and payment records regularly throughout the season. Players not demonstrating regular payments (or complete payment) will be excluded from further selection (Outdoor / Indoor) and will pay the complete balance of their fees to date - plus 50% of their outstanding (Outdoor / Indoor) subscription before being considered eligible to play for the club in any league, cup or friendly match.

4b. DWHC will assess each junior members subscription status and payment records regularly throughout the season. Players not demonstrating regular payments (or complete payment) will be excluded from further selection (Outdoor / Indoor) and will pay the complete balance of their annual subscription before once again becoming eligible for selection in any league, cup or friendly match.

- 1 The Standing Order system is in place to allow members to balance their monthly expenditure over the entire hockey season. Payments do not stop during any winter shutdown of outdoor hockey or cancellation of matches due to bad weather.
- 2 No "full" refund can be considered after a player has been registered with the SHU. Any member wishing to leave the club should contact the Treasurer / Secretary at the earliest opportunity to negotiate any refund. Any refund would take into account the players contributions to date and the clubs cost in registering said player, etc.
- 3 Standing Orders:- Ten equal payments of the annual subscription shall commence in September 2011 - on a day / date chosen **by the member**; payments must be complete by 30th. June 2012.

- 1 Senior Club - Affiliation - £50
Junior Club - Affiliation - £50

- 2 Senior club must provide list of names of players - irrespective of age playing National, Reserve, Regional or District Hockey.
Each Senior must pay an individual SHU registration fee (see Note 3 for casuals.)
A Junior player playing in a Senior Hockey League (SHU National, Regional or District) must pay an individual registration fee (£16), but for occasional games is levied at the same rate as an "adult casual" - see note 3
The Junior Section must provide a List of members (i.e., Under 14's) : members in this category do not pay an individual registration fee, and are covered by the Junior Club Affiliation fee.
Registration / player for a player playing Indoor National League Hockey only = £16
Registration / non player = £32 (e.g., umpire, manager, etc.)

- 3 A "casual" player can play 3 games at a cost of £5 - but the full SHU Registration Fee of £30 becomes payable after the 3rd match. Should be paid within 1 week of playing the 4th match..

- 4 Regular checks are carried out on all National and Regional League Match Report Forms to ensure players are 14 or older, and that they are properly registered.
District league match forms SHOULD ALSO be checked for player age and registration. This area is now recognised as being the one where most errors take place where team managers / captains bring youngsters up from the junior ranks and play them without secretaries / treasurers being aware.
If it can be established that these youngsters are playing more than 3 times for a team playing in an MHU league, then the same fine will be levied as playing an adult for the same number of games.

- 5 Players under the age of 14 years are permitted to participate in competitions run under the auspices of MHU - under the condition that the Club has been provided with a fully completed Parental Consent Form by the parents / guardian of that child.
Players under the age of 14 years are NOT permitted to participate in any competitions (League, Cup or Plate) run under the auspices of the SHU.

Payments to the SHU are subject to change each year - but have not yet been published.
