



Tayside Dressage Group Conduct & Grievance Policy

Conduct of British Riding Club (BRC) Members

No BRC Member shall:

1. Conduct themselves at any competition in a manner which is offensive to the public.
2. At any competition argue, behave with incivility or contempt, or use abusive or threatening language, towards a judge, official or other competitor.
3. Conduct themselves in a manner detrimental to the character and/or prejudicial to the interests of the BRC.
4. Make, either orally or in writing, to an officer of the BRC or Club, or a third party, a statement on a matter covered by the rules which they know to be untrue.
5. Smoke when mounted or on foot in an enclosed public place.

If any member is found in breach of any of the above they may find themselves in front of the Disciplinary Committee who will take appropriate action.

Tayside Dressage Group (TDG) Complaints Procedure

1. If any member feels aggrieved about any incident they should speak to any member of the TDG Committee whom they feel comfortable with. This member will offer advice as to how to proceed. This may be discussed with another committee member with complainer present.
2. All complaints are dealt with in a confidential manner and are logged by the club's secretary.
3. A serious complaint will be discussed by the committee but the committee will seek advice from BRC regarding further action.
